This option was adopted by Avera Health and consequently in December 2008 the Plan deferral was discontinued and all accrued benefits were distributed January 2009 to the individual participants. Participants however were required to pay income tax on the distribution in 2008. This deferred compensation plan was established in 1995. The distribution from the plan therefore represents contributions for 14 years plus any investment gains that have accrued on those balances over the years represented.
