A comparative job analysis was prepared by the CFO utilizing comparable market based survey data. The analysis was provided to the Chairman and Board of Directors for use in determining the annual compensation for the CEO. The CFO is a CCP (Certified Compensation Professional) and has over twenty years of experience in compensation design and has worked as a compensation roonsultant. The comparable market data included three professional industry salary surveys. Additionally, the 990s of multiple organizations with similar scope, operations, positions and geographic location were utilized in the analysis. After reviewing comparable compensation data and providing 360 degree performance feedback, the Board and its committees recommended and approved the annual CEO compensation. This formal compensation program includes job descriptions, annual evaluations, comparable market based salary data and compensation philosphy that supports the mission, goals and objectives of the organization.
