A) Daily Meals: Nutritionally balanced hot meals are provided seven days a week to people who visit the Center and are delivered to the infirm and homebound. This service is critical for the center and the community it serves. Without these daily meals many seniors would go hungry.

B) Grocery Distribution Program: Qualified participants can select groceries once a week at the Center.

C) Emergency Food Assistance: Our food closet distributes basic food items, three meals a day for three or four days, to individuals or families who lack financial resources to purchase food.

Transportation:

Our handicapped-accessible vehicles provide daily shuttle service to and from the Center, deliver meals to the homebound, and transport people to grocery stores and medical and other appointments.

Social & Recreational Services:

A) Social: St. Patrick's is a source of information and referral for people needing assistance in accessing health care, filing taxes, dealing with Social Security issues, or securing food stamps. Educational sessions on a variety of important topics are also scheduled regularly at the Center.

B) Recreation: At St. Patrick's Center, friends gather in a secure, friendly environment to play cards and other games, solve puzzles, or enjoy television, musical programs, picnics, and other activities. Day trips for recreation and shopping are scheduled regularly.

C) Empowerment: We direct the programs and services at St. Patrick's toward preventive care and are vitally concerned about reaching out to
