After presentation and approval by those two boards, the Finance & Capital Board of the Washington County Health System ("System") would evaluate the financial implications of the joint venture. The Audit & Business Integrity Committee of the System Board would analyze any possible interested party transactions and the limitations and prohibitions associated with the section 501(c)(3) status of the Hospital. The System Board would ultimately need to approve any joint venture resolutions.
