The Executive satisfied this employment condition and received a total payment of \$1,122,391, the total payment under the Retention Plan. These payments represented the final payment due to the Executive under all supplemental plans. Mr. Crowley, Executive Vice President of the Organization, received a distribution of the entire balance to his credit under the Organization's Supplemental Executive Retirement Plan II ("SERP II"), covering certain executives other than the President and Chief Executive Officer. The amount of the SERP II distribution to Mr. Crowley was \$644,812.
