PARAMEDIC, MAJOR DISASTER RESPONSE AND CRITICAL INCIDENT DEBREIFINGS. THE TOTAL COST OF PROGRAM SERVICES PROVIDED WAS \$405,022, \$235,917 OF THAT BEING IN THE FORM OF CASH GRANTS.
