




These individuals are required read and sign the conflict of interest policy. They are also required to disclose all relationships with other organizations in writing. Upon disclosure of a perceived or actual conflict of interest the organization will determine whether the person may fully participate in the deliberations and voting on the proposal under consideration at that time. The president of the Academy and the board liaison will evaluate the facts when the chair person is the one with the possible conflict. Otherwise the chair and the board liaison will do so. If it is determined that a conflict does exist and the person cannot fully discharge the duties of the position, the person will either be excused from the discussion/vote or be required to submit resignation.


