Form 990 is being amended to reflect consistency with an amended Form 990-T.

Page 9, line 6d, net rental loss of \$(634,882) has been reclassified to column (D) on this amended return from column (C) on original return.

The organization was audited in 1991 in which the IRS made the determination that the net rental income from the organization was not trade or business income due to net losses from the activity, citing Portland Golf Club vs. Commissioner, 90-1 USTC 500,332.

Accordingly, the net rental losses should be classified as excluded revenue, column (D) 41, under exemption code 41, income from an activity not operated with the intent to make a profit.
