Child care scholarships were provided for 210 children at 58 local child care facilities to enable parents to work or continue their education. Enhanced subsidy payments were provided to 30, 4 and 5 star licensed facilities serving an average of 533 subsidized children per month to help offset the cost of high quality child care.

406 parents received information about high quality child care and 275 accessed materials to enhance their child's development. 60 child care facilities received on-site consultations to improve the quality of care. 401 child care professionals attended at least one training to enhance their knowledge and skills, 153 parents attended parent trainings to help better prepare their child for school.

Health and Safety: 70 child care facilities received on-site consultations to improve health, safety and nutrition practices; 145 child care professionals received on-site consultations and 99 received training to assist them in meeting the needs of children with special needs; 122 parents received one-on-one consultations to help them adopt healthy behaviors at home; 133 families received transportation to health services; 26 primary care practitioners received service to help increase the number of children receiving developmental screenings; 140 uninsured children received medical care and 291 uninsured women received prenatal care.

All conflicted persons will be asked to vacate the room until the issue is resolved. (If these parties are necessary to maintain quorum, they may remain without voice or vote.)
- D. The person known to have a Conflict of Interest may not vote on the Contract or Transaction. The official minutes shall reflect that the Conflict of Interest was disclosed and person(s) with the Conflict were not present during the vote and did not vote on the matter.

Part VI, Section C, line 19: A "public file" is maintained for inspection upon request at an office of the organization.
