THE DECREASE IN TOTAL REVENUE FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 07-08 TO THE FISCAL YEAR 08-09, IS DUE TO THREE PRIMARY FACTORS: 1) IN APRIL, 2008 THE CEO OF THE FOUNDATION LEFT THE ORGANIZATION AND ALTHOUGH AN INTERIM CEO WAS PUT IN PLACE, THE CURRENT CEO DID NOT TAKE CHARGE UNTIL MID-NOVEMBER, 2008 (DURING THIS TIME PERIOD THE FOUNDATION'S PRIMARY FUND RAISING EVENT WAS HELD). IN THE FUND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT, TWO VACANCIES OCCURRED NOVEMBER, 2008 AND MARCH, 2009, FILLED JUNE 2009; 2) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007-08, REVENUE INCLUDED \$1,280,000 OF SIGNIFICANT ONE-TIME GIFTS THAT WERE NOT REPEATABLE; AND, 3) ECONOMIC CONDITIONS IN THE ATLANTA AREA WERE NOT FAVORABLE FOR FUNDRAISING. BETWEEN STAFF TRANSITION AND THE ADVERSE IMPACT OF THE DECLINE IN THE ECONOMY, REVENUES ALSO DECLINED.
