Part I, Line 3c The Federal Poverty Guidelines for income are the basis for determining eligibility for charity care discounts. For example, individuals with incomes below 100% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines will be eligible for free care. Individuals with incomes greater than 100% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines may be eligible for care at discounted rates depending on their income level and/or the amount due to the hospital. Charity/Medical Indigence parameters are based on Federal Income Poverty (FPL) Guidelines which are updated annually Generally, no patient's financial responsibility shall be greater than 20% of the household adjusted gross income, subject to an asset test. This determination shall be made per episode of care where income exceeds 300% of the FPL, and, when warranted, in aggregate for multiple episodes. The parameters will be reviewed annually with the FPL updates. The review will include assessment of the sliding scale ranges, maximum out of pockets, and overall impact to the facilities and system. Revisions will be completed as warranted.
