The funds management functions ensure that the financial aid records and the general ledger records reconcile to each other. Monitoring is also achieved through numerous reports specific to - the aid code, the various types of grants, the various forms of grants and each funding source. Annual Audits Annual audits are conducted by independent public accountants who provide an opinion as to whether federal and certain state funded programs are exercised in compliance with the laws and regulations governing such program.
