

#### 1. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

#### A. Organization

Desert View, Inc was established in 1995 and incorporated as a nonprofit organization under the laws of the State of New Mexico to provide counseling services to victims of violence and other related mental health patients. In addition, Desert View began operations of a shelter in 2005. Desert View operates under a Board of Directors. Funding is provided principally by Federal, state, and private grants.

Desert View reports three programs as follows:

Counseling and Treatment Programs - Several programs provide licensed counseling and treatment for individuals and families who may have been victims of domestic violence, drug abuse, or who may need social and family intervention treatment.

Sarah's House - This program provides a shelter and a temporary home for women who have been abused or victimized by domestic violence.

VOCA/VAWA Program - This program is funded by a federal grant to provide assistance to victims of domestic abuse.

### B. Financial Statement Presentation and Basis of Accounting

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared in conformity with the requirements of an Industry Audit Guide entitled Not-For Profit Organizations issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The Organization reports information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets (unrestricted, temporarily restricted, and permanently restricted) based upon the existence or absence of donor-imposed restrictions. The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

#### C. Income Taxes

Desert View, Inc. is exempt from income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

#### 1. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies (cont.)

#### D. <u>Functional Allocation of Expenses</u>

The costs of providing the various programs and other activities have been summarized on a functional basis in the statement of activities, and statement of functional expenses. Accordingly, certain expenses have been allocated based on estimates and proportionate actual costs among their programs and supporting services benefited.

#### E. Property and Equipment

Capital purchases for property and equipment with a cost over \$250 are recorded as depreciable assets. Normal maintenance and repairs are expensed as incurred. The property consisting of furniture, equipment, and building are depreciated on the straight line methods over their estimated useful lives of five to seven years, except the building which is depreciated over 27.5 years. The title to assets purchased with some grantor funds are retained by the grantor until released or disposed.

#### F. Donated Goods and Services

Donated goods and services are measured at fair market value at the date of receipt. Donations consist of consumable goods used in the course of providing services and have been recorded in these financial statements. Volunteer services have not been recorded in the financial statements.

#### G. Promises to Give Contributions

The Organization adopted SFAS No. 116, Accounting for Contributions Received and Contributions Made, in 1997. In accordance with SFAS 116, contributions received are recorded as unrestricted, temporarily restricted, or permanently restricted support depending on the existence or nature of any donor restrictions. Promises to give contributions are recognized when the donor makes a promise to give to the organization that is, in substance, unconditional. Contributions that are restricted by the donor are reported as increases in unrestricted net assets if the restrictions expire in the fiscal year in which the contributions are recognized. All other donor-restricted contributions are reported as increases in temporarily or permanently restricted net assets depending on the nature of the restrictions. When a restriction expires, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets. The organization had no temporarily or permanently restricted net assets.

#### 4. Cash Equivalents and Collateral of Bank Accounts

The organization's cash presented on the balance sheet includes demand deposits in checking accounts, and are considered cash equivalents for purposes of the statement of cash flows. The bank accounts are secured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (F.D.I.C.) up to \$250,000. Deposits are fully insured by F.D.I.C. coverage.

#### 5. Grants Receivable

The Organization records as a receivable the amount of contract revenue that it has earned but not received as of June 30, 2009. The amount of \$53,643 for year ending June 30, 2009 consists of contracts with the State of New Mexico, and other organizations, and is considered fully collectable. There has been no provision for an allowance for doubtful accounts.

#### 6. Contingencies and Commitments

The Organization receives financial assistance from Federal and state sources in the form of grants and contracts. The funds received are generally limited to specific compliance requirements as specified in the grant agreement. The government agencies reserve the right to review the scope of the audit and conduct a follow-up review if deemed necessary. Any disallowed claims resulting from such audits could become a liability of the Organization. The Organization, however, believes that liability resulting from disallowed claims, if any, will not have a material effect on the financial position. For the year ended June 30, 2009, the Organization received approximately 80% percent of its revenues from contracts with the government agencies.

#### 7. Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles require management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### 8. <u>Long Term Liabilities</u>

Long term liabilities consist of a mortgage for the acquisition of the building used as the shelter (Sarah's House). The acquisition is capitalized with a resulting liability and depreciation. The total mortgage of \$84,750 from New Mexico Finance Authority is a non-amortizing loan over 240 months due January 1, 2025 at 1% interest per year beginning December 8, 2004. Accrued interest for years ending June 30, 2009 was \$3,870. The total mortgage principal and interest at June 30, 2009 is \$88,620.

#### 9. <u>Discontinued Operations</u>

Sarah's House, the shelter operation started in 2005, has been discontinued in November 2008. The property consisting of the building is currently for sale or available for transfer to another Organization that will use the property within the terms of the contract from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. The land is owned by the City of Aztec. If Desert View sells the building the proceeds from the sale will be used to pay off the mortgage and interest accrued through the date of sale.

#### 10. Note Payable - Current Liability

The Organization has obtained an unsecured line of credit with a current due date of October 2009. The terms of the line of credit include a current interest rate of 6.00%. The line of credit will be paid back in the next current year.
