There were 21,887 patients admitted for inpatient medical care for a total of 74,933 patient days. There were 220,417 outpatient visits out of which 53,660 were for emergency care visits. The Hospital delivered 4,080 bables. Overlake Medical Clinics provided 73,623 patient visits. Overlake Hospital demonstrated a commitment to improving the health of the community by supporting many health-related events, programs, clinical research and made various contributions throughout the year that had a direct benefit to the community. The Hospital maintains records to identify and monitor the level of charty care it provides. These records include the amount of charges foregone for services. Overlake Hospital provided care to 2,643 patients who are uninsured or under insured in the amount of \$8,361,000 (estimated cost of \$3,340,000). The Hospital provided care to Medicaid patients at rates below the cost of providing services.
