WMEA PROVIDES ITS FINANCIAL STATEMENTS TO INTERESTED PARTIES UPON REQUEST. AS NOTED IN THE EXPLANATION FOR PART VI, LINE 12C, GOVERNANCE POLICIES HAVE HISTORICALLY BEEN FOLLOWED IN PRINCIPLE, AND WMEA IS IN THE PROCESS OF FORMAL DOCUMENTATION. ONCE DOCUMENTED AND APPROVED, GOVERNANCE POLICIES WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO INTERESTED PARTIES UPON REQUEST.
