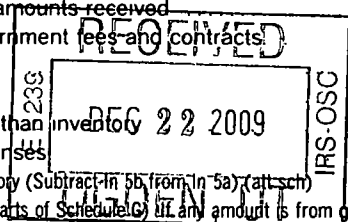





We also surveyed service gaps in Alameda County because 30% of the young women detained in San Francisco are from Alameda, and presented the results to the San Francisco Juvenile Justice Commission, which expressed overwhelming support for this project.
