- SHELTER PARTNERSHIP REINFORCES ITS PROVISION OF BASIC ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE IMMENSELY SUCCESSFUL S. MARK TAPER FOUNDATION SHELTER RESOURCE BANK PROJECT. SINCE 1989, THE AWARD-WINNING S. MARK TAPER FOUNDATION SHELTER RESOURCE BANK HAS SECURED MORE THAN \$164 MILLION WORTH OF NEW, HIGH-PRIORITY GOODS AND HAS DISTRIBUTED \$154 MILLION OF THESE GOODS, FREE OF CHARGE, TO MORE THAN 450 UNDUPLICATED AGENCIES/PROJECTS SERVING THE HOMELESS AND THE VERY POOR.

ALSO SECURED \$6 MILLION IN NEW GOODS. THESE GOODS INCLUDE INFANT AND CHILDREN'S CLOTHING AND SHOES, DIAPERS AND TOYS, PERSONAL CARE PRODUCTS, PAPER PRODUCTS, CLEANING SUPPLIES, MEN'S AND WOMEN'S NEW CLOTHING, AND MORE.

THIS WAS ONE OF THE MAJOR INITIATIVES PROPOSED IN OUR HOMELESS OLDER ADULTS STRATEGIC PLAN RELEASED IN MARCH 2008.
- SHELTER PARTNERSHIP'S TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE HAS LED TO SEVEN NEW PERMANENT, SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROJECTS IN DEVELOPMENT OR PREDEVELOPMENT WITH A TOTAL OF 200 UNITS RESERVED FOR HOMELESS OLDER ADULTS IN THE LOS ANGELES AREA. THIS WAS A SECOND MAJOR INITIATIVE PROPOSED IN THE HOMELESS OLDER ADULTS STRATEGIC PLAN.
- BEGAN A MAJOR ONGOING INITIATIVE TO ASSIST NEW IMAGE EMERGENCY SHELTER, THE LARGEST OVERNIGHT SHELTER IN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES WITH MORE THAN 450 MEN AND WOMEN NIGHTLY, SECURE AFFORDABLE, PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING ON BEHALF OF THEIR CLIENTS-MANY OF WHOM ARE CHRONICALLY HOMELESS WITH MULTIPLE DISABILITIES.
- REVIEWED SIX STATE-MANDATED LOCAL HOUSING ELEMENTS PREPARED BY JURISDICTIONS IN LOS ANGELES COUNTY AND PROVIDED EXTENSIVE COMMENTS ON: 1) THE JURISDICTION'S PLAN TO MEET ITS REGIONAL HOUSING NEED ALLOCATION, SPECIFICALLY FOR EXTREMELY LOW-INCOME HOUSEHOLDS; 2) THE REGULATION OF HOUSING FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES; AND 3) THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SENATE BILL 2 THAT ADDRESSES THE NEED TO PLAN FOR EMERGENCY SHELTERS AND PERMANENT, SUPPORTIVE HOUSING FOR THE HOMELESS. AS A RESULT, THESE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS ARE ADDRESSING THESE CONCERNS TO ASSURE THAT THEIR HOUSING ELEMENTS MEET STATE LAW.
