The organization operates four apartment complexes, providing homes for 48 individuals, ten domiciliary homes for 42 people, and seven intermediate care facilities/mental retardation (group homes) for 32 individuals. Each home has 4-5 residents, as well as a live-in manager and is located in a community setting. The homes provide a family atmosphere, with opportunities to work, learn and play together. Living skills are practiced daily.  Includes depreciation of \$129,185
