Line 12c – Conflict of Interest Policy

A list of conflicts or potential conflicts of interest is maintained by the staff. This list is reviewed by the directors and committee members at the beginning of each meeting. During this time everyone is asked it there has been any change in their conflicts of interest. If there are changes, the list is updated and the minutes of the meeting reflect the changes. In addition, once a year at the annual meeting, each director reviews the list, re-reads the Conflict of Interest Policy and signs the Policy saying they agree to be bound by it.

During a meeting if a subject arises where someone has a conflict, that person leaves the meeting and the minutes so note that. The record of that discussion is pulled out of the regular minutes and done as a confidential addendum. The addendum is not distributed but is available in the Records Book maintained in the office.

If a project is being developed where someone has a conflict, that person resigns from the board. They may or may not be invited back once the project is complete.

Line 15 b - Process for determining Executive Director's compensation

The Executive Committee of the Board reviews the performance and salary of the Executive

Director (ED). The committee first meets with the ED to review his performance using the goals
set by the board in their annual work plan and the corp. strategic plans. Someone on the committee,
usually the President of the Board, gathers a compensation survey for like positions. Once all the
data is collected and the review is complete, the committee, in consultation with the board, sets the
compensation for the ED.
