

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INSTRUMENT WITNESSETH:

FIRST: Pursuant to the above-quoted provisions of Article TENTH of the Indenture, the undersigned, JAIME E. YORDAN, KEVIN W. KENNEDY and MICHAEL R. LYNCH, hereby amend Article SIXTH of the Indenture by deleting said Article in its entirety and substituting therefor the following:

"SIXTH: (1) Subject to Paragraph (2) below, the Trustees may act on any matter without a meeting by any instrument signed by a majority of the Trustees then acting. They may also hold meetings on such

notice and at such place and time as they may from time to time determine, and any action taken by a majority of the Trustees at any such meeting, provided that a majority of all Trustees then acting were present at the meeting, shall constitute the action of the Trustees.

(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Indenture, any distribution of the net income or principal of the trust pursuant to Article FIRST of this Indenture shall require the unanimous consent of all Trustees then acting.

(3) Any Trustee not participating in an action of the Trustees, or not concurring in a decision of a majority of the Trustees acting by written instrument or present at a meeting, shall not be responsible or liable for any action taken or omitted to be taken by such majority of the Trustees. Except with respect to a distribution of the net income or principal of the trust, any person dealing with the Trustees may rely upon the act of the majority and shall not require other Trustees to join any act.


