These delegates will represent the Greater Portland USBC at the State and National convention, where they will be voting on legislative item etc. ADDITIONAL PROGRAMS REQUIRED BY HEADQUARTERS are also covered under this section. Registered Volunteer program (which was implemented as a background screen program to help ensure a safe environment for USBC youth members), lane certification and year book expense (totaling \$4,512). PART VIII STATEMENT OF REVENUE: Line 1f = dollars received as a direct by-product of the tournaments we are required to run by headquarters each year. At the end of the year, dollars are presented to the charities. PART IX STATE OF FUNCTIONAL EXPENSES, LINE 4: These dollars indicate pay outs from tournaments. LINE 21, PAYMENTS TO AFFILIATES: These dollars reflect headquarter's portion of the dues paid by each member of Greater Portland USBC. \$1.00 from each membership (approximately 10,000 members) is fowarded to the State for operating costs. STATEMENTS REGARDING OTHER IRS FILINGS: Our understanding is that if the building is not encumbered by debt, then the rental income is excluded from tax and a 990-T is not required. OTHER IRS FILINGS: The 990 is completed and reviewed by the Association Manager after there has been an audit completed. At the annual meeting the audited financial statements along with a copy of the 990 is presented to the membership. At that time, should there be adjustments required, an amended 990 is filed. After review is completed a copy of the 990 and/or any other documents are available via request on the website and/or phone call to the office. SCHEDULE D: PART X BVL - These are charity funds that should have been donated to BVL when the three entities merged in 2005, however they were missed. These dollars were forwarded to BVL this year.
