Grants and Donations

Statement of Policy

WD Foundation (the "Foundation") supports established and successful non-profit organizations serving the communities in which Western Digital's U.S. operations are based, i.e., Lake Forest, San Jose and Fremont, California.

WD Foundation Budget

The Foundation currently receives its funding from three primary sources:

- Each year Western Digital Corporation supports the Foundation by making a financial contribution consistent with corporate priorities driven by a defined target range of earnings.
- Employees are asked to make voluntary individual gifts to the Foundation either through payroll deduction or by making direct financial gifts such as cash, checks, credit card, or donation of stock.

- 6. Meet the Foundation's emphasis areas of programs supporting education and health and human services as defined above; and
- 7. All proposals must have the support of the organizations volunteer constituency recognized by having a volunteer signature on the grant request.
