The institution covers any difference not funded with investment proceeds. The grants are administered by the institutions Vice Chancellor for Grants and Internships, a position specially created to supervise the proper administration of the institutional scholarship programs. Chancellors Scholarship - The Chancellors at each institution have created an Annual Find that includes moneys from institutional activities or operational funds. These funds are assigned discretionally by each Chancellor to needy students or to students that ar
