- c.) Youth, adult, and senior recreational activities. Activities such as vacation camp for children, enrichment classes for children, adult basketball, senior luncheons, Eldersize classes, youth sports, youth chorus, and various other programs. Approximately 400 individuals participate.
- d.) Campaign Allocations the Organization conducts an annual fundraising campaign and the contributions, after deducting fundraising expenses, are distributed to various Jewish organizations.
