If the office of any Trustee becomes vacant by reason of death, resignation, disqualification or inability to act, but notwithstanding such vacancy, there remain at least five (5) members serving on the Board of Trustees, the remaining Trustees, may, by a majority vote, but need not, elect a successor to serve for the unexpired term.
