Consideration is given to the breadth and complexity of programs, such as medical and law schools. The review also includes an assessment of the duties and responsibilities of each officer and the overall performance of each. The Committee reviews its recommendations with the Board of Trustees for final approval. The actions of the Committee and Board of Trustees are set forth in the minutes, including the information reviewed in determining comparability and the basis for determining that the compensation is reasonable.
