RE: Office of Child Welfare Parental Defense Annual Report

I hereby submit the Annual Report of the Office of Child Welfare Parental Defense as required by UCA 63A-11-106. The duties, functions and responsibilities of the office include:

- Providing assistance and advice to parental defense attorneys;
- Developing and providing educational and training programs for parental defense attorneys;
- Providing information and advice to assist parental defense attorneys to comply with their professional, contractual, and ethical duties.

As authorized by UCA 63A-11-105(2), the Department of Administrative Services entered into a contract with the Parental Defense Alliance of Utah (PDA), to perform the duties of the Office of Child Welfare Parental Defense. The contract is currently in the second year of a renewal and extension.

The Child Welfare Parental Defense Oversight Committee (Oversight Committee) continues to provide advise to the to the Office of Child Welfare Parental Defense and the PDA. The Oversight Committee is scheduled to meet on a quarterly basis and has met twice in 2008.

In fulfilling its obligations under the contract and meeting the responsibilities of the Office of Child Welfare Parental Defense, the PDA has, since the last report:

- o Produced and held a two-day conference for parental defense attorneys. The PDA sought input from practitioners and, in response to suggestions made by last year's attendees, included smaller breakout sessions in the conference schedule.
- Extended financial assistance to parental defendants who have been found by the court to be indigent for expert witness services, paralegal services on appeal, and court transcripts for appeals, subject to certain monetary limits. Only two counsel requested financial assistance.

- Conducted training seminars giving attorneys throughout Utah Continuing Legal Education.
- Continued to confer with, and act as a resource for parental defense attorneys in Utah. Some of the issues on which assistance was provided were: discovery, procedural and time requirements, possible courses of action, and admissibility of evidence. The PDA also continued to observe practice in different courtrooms and engaged judges, assistant attorneys general and guardians ad litem to obtain information in order to assist in improving the practice of parental defenders.
- Continued to provide valuable information to parental defenders via ebulletins and newsletters. Attorneys receive information on community resources, family advocates, Child Welfare Ombudsman, as well as, legislative and legal updates, and news items relevant to representing parents.
- Continued maintaining and uploading content to the website in order in efforts to make it more robust.
- Expenditures under the contract between the Department of Administrative Services and the PDA have once again been used as an "in kind match" for a federal grant submitted by the Court Improvement Project for court training programs.
- o 138 Attorneys trained for a total of 1240.5 hours of training provided.

The PDA continues to solicit practitioners for ideas about educational and training opportunities to help ensure that it continues to provide effective training to parental defense attorneys.
