Hendrick Health Systems current philosophy is to use ranges built around the median of the market with a 50% spread from minimum to maximum. Incentive opportunity levels are competitive with practices of peer groups and benefits will be delivered at market competitive levels. Severance and perquisites reflect a conservative philosophy. The Committee determined that the peer group would be primarily regional not-for-profit hospitals of similar size and complexity.
