# Policy

It is the policy of the Township Officials of Illinois ("TOI") to retain records as required by law and to destroy them when appropriate. Some records, even though not required by law, should be retained permanently, such as audited financial statements, some personnel records, minutes, legal correspondence, tax records, or other documents that may be important to the organization or eligible for its archives.

The destruction of records must be approved by the TOI President or Finance Chair, and logged into the TOI's Destroyed Records Log. The formal records retention policy of TOI is as follows:

# Electronic Record Keeping

It is the policy of TOI to maintain electronic record keeping that allows for the production of legible records. Machine sensitive records must be readily retrievable and contain sufficient transaction-level detail to identify any source documents. Documentation of procedures, file contents, and system checks is required.

Computer generated documents relating to the above records, such as email, spreadsheets, tables and graphs, letters, graphics and photographic images should be retained 7 years.

Voicemail that is believed by staff to be relevant to existing or potential litigation should be forwarded to the Executive Director to be tape recorded and stored. All other voicemail messages are retained at the discretion of individual staff members, and should be removed before the storage capacity of the telephone system is reached.

Email messages are to be retained at the discretion of individual staff members. However, all data composed, received, and/or stored on TOI's Personnel Policies regarding computer and email usage.

## Storage of Back-Up Files

It is the policy of TOI to maintain back-up copies of electronic data files off-site in a secure, fire-protected environment. Access to back-up files shall be limited to individuals authorized by management.

As employees and representatives of Township Officials of Illinois, we must practice honesty and integrity in fulfilling our responsibilities and comply with all applicable laws and regulations.

#### FRAUD POLICY

# Scope

This policy applies to any fraud or suspected fraud involving employees, officers or directors, as well as members, vendors, consultants, contractors, funding sources and/or any other parties with a business relationship with Township Officials of Illinois ("TOI"). Any investigative activity required will be conducted without regard to the suspected wrongdoer's length of service, position/title, or relationship with TOI.

# **Policy**

Management is ultimately responsible for the detection and prevention of fraud, misappropriations, and other irregularities. Fraud is defined as the intentional, false representation or concealment of a material fact for the purpose of inducing another to act upon it to his or her injury.

Any fraud that is detected or suspected by an employee of TOI must be reported immediately to the Executive Director or to a member of the Executive Committee.

# Actions Constituting Fraud

The terms fraud, defalcation, misappropriation, and other fiscal irregularities refer to, but are not limited to:

- 1. Any dishonest or fraudulent act.
- 2. Forgery or alteration of any document or account belonging to TOI.
- 3. Forgery or alteration of a check, bank draft, or any other financial document.
- 4. Misappropriation of funds, securities, supplies, equipment, or other assets of TOL
- 5. Impropriety in the handling or reporting of money or financial transactions.
- 6. Disclosing confidential and proprietary information to outside parties.
- 7. Accepting or seeking anything of material value from contractors, vendors, or persons providing goods or services to TOI. Exception: gifts less than \$25.00 in value
- 8. Destruction, removal or inappropriate use of records, furniture, fixtures, and equipment.
- 9. Any similar or related irregularity.

# Other Irregularities

Irregularities concerning an employee's moral, ethical, or behavioral conduct should be resolved by TOI's Executive Director.

If such irregularities involve the Executive Director, the employee shall contact the Executive Committee.

If there is a question as to whether an action constitutes fraud, contact the Executive Director or a member of the Executive Committee for guidance.

## Investigation Responsibilities

The Executive Committee has the primary responsibility for the investigation of all suspected fraudulent acts as defined in the policy. The Executive Committee may utilize whatever internal and/or external resources it considers necessary in conducting an investigation. If an investigation substantiates that fraudulent activities have occurred, the Executive Committee will issue reports to appropriate designated personnel and, if appropriate, to TOI's Board of Directors.

Decisions to prosecute or refer the examination results to the appropriate law enforcement and/or regulatory agencies for independent investigation will be made in conjunction with legal counsel and TOI's Board of Directors, as will final dispositions of the case.

# Confidentiality

The Executive Committee and the Executive Director shall treat all information received confidentially. Any employee who suspects dishonest or fraudulent activity will notify the Executive Director or a member of the Executive Committee immediately, and should not attempt to personally conduct investigations or interviews/interrogations related to any suspected fraudulent act (see Reporting Procedures section below).

Investigation results will not be disclosed or discussed with anyone other than those who have a legitimate need to know. This is important in order to avoid damaging the reputations of persons suspected but subsequently found innocent of wrongful conduct and to protect TOI from potential civil liability.

# Authority for Investigation of Suspected Fraud

Members of the Executive Committee will have:

- 1. Free and unrestricted access to all TOI records and premises, whether owned or rented; and
- 2. The authority to examine, copy, and/or remove all or any portion of the contents of files, desks, cabinets, and other storage facilities on the premises without prior knowledge or consent of any individual who may use or have custody or any such items or facilities when it is within the scope of their investigations.

# Reporting Procedures

Great care must be taken in the investigation of suspected improprieties or irregularities so as to avoid mistaken accusations or alerting suspected individuals that an investigation is under way.

An employee who discovers or suspects fraudulent activity will contact the Executive Director or a member of the Executive Committee immediately. The employee or other complainant may remain anonymous. All inquiries concerning the activity under investigation from the suspected individual(s), his or her attorney or representative(s), or any other inquirer should be directed to the Executive Director, the Executive Committee, or legal counsel. No information concerning the status of an investigation will be given out. The proper response to any inquiry is "I am not at liberty to discuss this matter." Under no circumstances should any reference be made to "the allegation", "the crime", "the fraud", "the forgery", "the misappropriation", or any other specific reference.

The reporting individual should be informed of the following:

- Do not contact the suspected individual in an effort to determine facts or I. demand restitution.
- Do not discuss the case, facts, suspicions, or allegations with anyone 2. unless specifically asked to do so by the TOI legal counsel, Executive Director, or the Executive Committee.
