We attended a marketing meeting in mid February hosted by Bill Hunt. We were able to listen and be enlightened on grain markets, conservation topics and local farmer discussion. A couple young farmers continue to attend the monthly meetings regularly which are a great way to stay up on the market.

The National Farm Bureau Annual convention was held in New Orleans this year. Thanks to you we were able to have a great number attend from our county including, Phil and Tracy Jelinek, Ray and Heidi Birchmeier, and Kim and Teresa Fejes. We learned about local and world wide Ag news and developments. At the convention our guest speaker was General Colin Powell and WOW, what an amazing person and speaker he was! We made time to take a trolley and toured the hurricane Katrina devastation which remains.

Our district event was to tour Fair Oaks Dairy Farm in Indiana. Fair Oaks Farms is home to 30,000 dairy cows located on 10 separate dairy sites. To grow silage corn and alfalfa to feed these 30,000 cows, it takes approximately 17,000 acres, 1.7 Billion square feet or the equivalent of 56,000 football fields. Each cow is milked three times per day, and more than 80,000 milkings are performed daily, in this 24 hour, 365 day-a-year dairy farm that never shuts down. If you ever get a chance to tour their facility, it is worth the drive!

In August our Young Farmers competed in the District Discussion Meet held at the MSU pavilion. I would like to thank Chad Morey and Brett Morey for representing our county so well. The topics this year were: How can the aging infrastructure of the United States support the transportation of agricultural commodities in the future? AND How do land grant universities remain on the forefront of an ever-changing agricultural environment?

In August the statewide Young Farmer golf scramble was hosted at Centennial Acres golf course. Genesee County had a record eight Young Farmers including myself participate in the golf scramble. Special thanks to Kim Fejes, Heidi Birchmeier, Nancy Birchmeier, Brett Morey, Chad Morey, Matt Oecsh for participating.

We all are SO PROUD to announce Ray Birchmeier was the State winner for the Young Farmer Achievement Award. Ray went up against 3 other contestants in his category and took on tough and lengthy interviews with the judges.
