Assistance to individuals is generally awarded from long standing Association programs. In 2008-09, a one-time Flood Bank fund was set-up to help victims of the 2008 floods in Iowa. Assistance to organizations is generally initiated by a request from that organization or at the request of an Association Board Member. Any assistance not directly provided for in the budget is approved by the Executive Board.
