PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Texas Filmmakers' Production Fund makes annual grants to emerging film and video artists in the state of Texas. Awards of up to \$15,000 are provided to artists whose work shows promise, skill, and creativity. For the first time this year, we are raising the limit on individual grants to \$25,000.

With the launch of the application in the spring, TFPF staff tour the state giving informational workshops on the Fund and grant-writing guidelines. Workshops are given in conjunction with regional film festivals, conferences, and with copresenting media arts organizations. Applicants are also encouraged to make preliminary review consultations with TFPF staff prior to the deadline. TFPF staff reviews the applications and provides feedback, offering suggestions for improvement. Phone appointments are available for out-of-town applicants.

Upon receipt of the applications and following the postmark deadline, applications are processed and reviewed for completeness. Applications are then split for preliminary review with a mix of narrative, documentary, animation and experimental applications going to each evaluator. The top-scoring applications (roughly one-third of the applications submitted) are reviewed at full panel session in Austin. Panelists make funding decisions regarding the final recipients and the amount awarded.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Eligibility and restrictions

Application must be made by the creative author of the final work. Awards will not be made to organizations.

- Applicant must have resided in Texas for at least 1 year prior to the application date.
- All genres of film or video are given equal consideration. AFS is unable to consider multimedia projects.
- Projects must be independent productions. "Independent production" means a production under the artistic, budgetary and editorial control of the individual owning copyright. No consideration will be given to industrial or promotional pieces or "works-for-hire."
- Application must be for the production, post-production or distribution stages. No consideration will be given for applications requesting preproduction or development funds.
- AFS staff and Board members and TFPF interns are ineligible to apply.

CRITERIA FOR REVIEW

Essential factors considered by panelists include:

- the quality of the proposed work based on the description, realistic budget, and supporting materials
- the likelihood that the work will be completed
- the applicant's demonstrated ability and creativity as seen in the representational work (film, video, or script) submitted.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants are asked to submit:

- application form and budget
- project description (1-3 pages)
- project timeline (1 page)
- project personnel (1 page)
- optional support material (no more than five pages)
- proof of TX residency
- video sample
- treatment or script (optional)

Applications must be mailed to the Austin Film Society by the postmark deadline. For the first time this year, applicants will also have the option of submitting at least part of their application online.
