- A community health assessment survey was commissioned by Hendrick in the fall of 2006 and was conducted the following spring. The primary objective was to establish a benchmark for the general health of the community that is served by Hendrick and use the resulting data in support of Hendrick's own self assessment as a non-profit organization. To execute the project, Hendrick partnered with staff and faculty from the Department of Management Science in the College of Business at Abilene Christian University. A modified form of the Behavioral Risk Factors Surveillance System questionnaire developed at the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention was used as the survey instrument. The questionnaire was mailed to a sample of 8,000 households in Taylor County. The sample was selected from a proprietary household list maintained by the Abilene Reporter News and is parent organization, E.W. Scripps Company. A total of 1,880 questionnaires were returned, for a response rate of 23.5%

Hendrick provides many opportunities for patient education on financial assistance.
