Its objective is to create quality job opportunities and stimulate economic activity. EMDC's role as a secondary lender is to work with banks and other private and public funding groups to leverage the capital available to small businesses. EMDC has several secondary loan funds to finance a wide variety of business needs, including equipment, real estate and working capital. Through our lending programs, EMDC offers direct loans of \$1,000 to \$4,000,000, creatively packaged with partners in the banking and investment communities. Since the inception of the program, in the early 1980's, EMDC has disbursed nearly \$60 million to over 500 companies, leveraging nearly \$187 million in other private and public funds. Over 10,000 jobs have been created or retained. EMDC currently has approximately \$13,850,000 in loan funds outstanding to 102 clients.
