(NLHA) is the principal provider of primary and secondary health care for 15 towns in Sullivan and Merrimack counties in New Hampshire. The towns in the NLHA service area are. Andover, Bradford, Croydon, Danbury, Goshen, Grantham, Lempster, Newbury, New London, Newport, Springfield, Sunapee, Sutton, Washington, and Wilmot and are largely representative of the state's rural population. The hospital provides acute and primary health care - from emergency services to family medical practice to neurosurgical care - and essential wellness and prevention services for the 34,000 residents in the area, a significant proportion of whom are uninsured, underinsured and/or dependent on Medicaid/Medicare benefits. This includes a large elderly population and a significant number of rural, low-income families. New London Hospital is a Critical Access Hospital with 25 beds and an extended care facility with 58 beds. NLHA also employs 44 providers. Twenty-three provide primary care in three practices, one of which is a pediatric practice, and 21 are specialists, including anesthisologists, neurology, emergency medicine, hospitalists, gynecology and ear, nose and throat In addition to the access to care and programs mentioned elsewhere in Form 990, Part III, NLHA provided \$1,768,077 in charity care in order to care for community members.
4b	(Code ) (Expenses \$ 12,799,499 including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ 13,430,563 )  Physician practices - the Organization provides the services of physicians to the community NLHA identified access to primary care as a central community need. As a result, the hospital is committed to providing care in central locations throughout the service area, specifically Newport and New London. The hospital subsidized the delivery of primary care to the community in the amount of \$2,660,911 in FY 2009. In addition, the hospital provided a Medication Bridge Program at a cost of \$19,433 that works with patients to ensure that prescription medication is available cost. Due to limited access to mental health services in the service area, NLHA partnered with West Central Behavioral Health to give patients access to care at a cost of \$113,512. Other community benefit programs provided by NLHA include a Breast & Cervical Cancer Program and Mammography Fund valued at \$4,970, two community health fairs valued at \$11,000, Safe Sitter classes valued at \$1,698, and an H1N1 outreach program valued at \$5,500. New Hampshire does not require towns to provide ambulance service and the NLHA ambulance service covers seven townsNew London, Sunapee, Springfield, Newbury, Sutton, Wilmot and Grantham providing \$301,912 of support with a paramedic level ambulance in addition, the ambulance service makes transfers, non-transport runs and Dartmouth—Hitchcock Medical Center assists. Paramedics intercept and assist area volunteer ambulance and FAST squads when needed. Emergency Medical Services education and training is provided by the hospital at a cost of \$44,393. The hospital also operates a 24/17 Emergency Department that is always staffed by a physician at a subsidized cost of \$434,458. School Health Services NLHA had several programs in the schools in response to past needs assessments that continue to address health concerns in our service area. The Rock Dental Clinic, staffed by a registered dental hygienist is a school-based oral health scre
