The Ticket to Reading Rewards SM (TTRR) program, founded in 2002, is a reading incentive program that encourages Middle School students to read books outside the classroom and obtain rewards for reading. The program has three primary components: reading rewards, tickets to local college basketball games and a coaching component for Middle School coaches to both learn new techniques and to act as mentors for the reading program.

The Foundation's Form 990 is prepared by the Foundation's staff and reviewed by the Foundation's external certified public accounting firm. The Form 990 is presented to the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors at the annual spring meeting. The Executive Committee reviews and approves the Form 990. The Executive Committee reports to the full Board of Directors that such action was taken. The Executive Committee and Board of Directors document the approval in their respective minutes. Subsequent to the Executive Committee approval, management files the Form 990 with the Internal Revenue Service.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 12c:

The Foundation conducts periodic reviews for monitoring proposed and ongoing transactions of conflict of interest. The Foundation requires that each Director and member of a committee with governing board delegated power sign an annual statement which affirms that they have received a copy of the conflict of interest policy; have read and understand the policy; have agreed to comply with the policy; and understands that the Foundation is tax-exempt and must engage primarily in activities that accomplish its tax-exempt purpose. The committee with governing board delegated power determines whether a conflict of interest has occurred based on the disclosure of the financial interest and all material facts of an interest person. This committee reviews all compensation arrangements and benefits to determine if they are reasonable. The Foundation's policy covers all interested persons who are defined as any director, principal officer or member of a committee with governing board delegated powers who have a direct or indirect financial interest in the Foundation. The committee will also review actual conflicts of interest. In the event of a conflict of interest, the committee will determine if any restrictions should be imposed on the interested person.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Lines 15a and 15b:

The Foundation's executive committee performs a review of all the compensation of the top managerial official as well as key employees. This review is performed annually.

Form 990, Part VI, Section C, Line 19:

The Foundation has a Public Inspection policy. This policy states that its governing documents, conflicts of interest policy and financial statements are available to the public for review during regular business hours at 1111 Main Street, Suite 1000, Kansas City, MO 64105. Any request for such filings will be made without charge except for the cost to reproduce and mail the filings. All requests must be made in person or in writing. If the request is made in person, the copies shall be provided immediately. For any written requests, the NABC shall provide the filings within 30 days of the request.
