Provide educational programming for natural resource preservation and stewardship, and integrate various aspects of the heritage of the Upper Housatonic River Valley – the social, cultural, economic and industrial history of the valley, the ecology of the river throughout that history, and the symbiotic relationship between that history and ecology. Portions of this programming may be broadened and adapted as part of the development of the Management Plan.

Projects include:

- The Upper Housatonic Valley Experience, a graduate level course for area teachers to build curriculum for local schools, in partnership with Mass. College of Liberal Arts, Berkshire Community College and Berkshire Chamber of Commerce.

- Work with Native American heritage groups to formulate the basis for placebased educational programming (historic) and for programming that ties to contemporary Native American culture.

• Heighten appreciation for the natural, cultural, and historic assets of the region through research and interpretive materials, signage and accessibility. Portions of this program of heightened appreciation may be adapted as it relates to the development of the Management Plan.

Projects include:

- Expand and broaden the diversity of Heritage Walks Weekends in Autumn, a collaboration of dozens of organizations and individuals who lead free, guided walks to visit a wide range of heritage destinations. Implement innovative marketing ideas to draw attention to the Heritage Walks by developing partnerships with regional tourism entities, online marketers and the media.
- Explore and celebrate contemporary and historic Native American culture through festivals, education and interpretive materials.
- Develop concepts of Performing Arts Heritage Trail. Entice the region's foremost performing-arts leaders to collaborate on a program to unite, explore and promote the collection of unique venues.
- Expand the depth of research and into the African American Heritage Trail, including work at the DuBois homestead and a new project celebrating the famed Massachusetts 54th Regiment.
- Spawn a multi-faceted project to explore and illuminate the roots of industry in the region.
- Work with partners to develop a regional system of walking, biking and hiking trails to connect people with heritage resources.

- Additional planning and implementation projects, archiving programs and interpretive materials pertaining to the region's industrial heritage. Specific programs include research projects of specific early industries (paper making, woolen, agriculture) and the migrant workers that permitted the foothold of industry in the region.
