Every year, approximately 600,000 children are born to low-income, first-time mothers in the U.S. who are at the greatest risk of suffering health, education and economic disparities. By offering support to this vulnerable population, Nurse-Family Partnership empowers pregnant women and their families to improve their health, education, and economic self-sufficiency.
