Activities:

The Foundation hosted special events (including the Charlotte Jumper Classic and My Heroes Gala), and made appeals for individual contributions to advance the work of the Foundation. In addition, the Foundation used its relationship with the players, coaches, and management of the Charlotte Bobcats NBA Team as a platform to raise awareness about the importance of literacy, education, health and fitness, and the arts. In order to meet the goals of the Foundation, the core focus of activities was grant making and raising awareness.

Grantmaking

Grantmaking was the Foundation's way of demonstrating and showcasing the Foundation's commitment to the priorities of the organization and community it serves. This year, eligible non-profit organizations were invited to submit grant applications for funding consideration. The community was made aware of the availability of grant dollars through press releases, the Foundation's website, and postcards mailed to eligible organizations. The volunteer board of directors, working with the President of the Foundation, granted various proposals. This year \$139,717 was granted to various non-profit organizations ranging from a grant to Presbyterian Hospital for the Medical Care Outreach program, the Taco Bell Foundation Community Teen Outreach, and several organizations for youth and community outreach programs.

Education and Awareness

Education and awareness represented the second priority area for the Foundation. Promotional campaigns such as billboards, in-arena public services announcements, as well as community public services announcements, posters, and informational literature were developed using players and coaches of the Charlotte Bobcats, as well as community leaders as spokespersons to raise community awareness about literacy, education, health and fitness, and the arts. These individuals used their standings in the community to promote issues important to the mission of the Foundation and the community it serves. The education and awareness campaigns align with the NBA basketball seasons and other national campaigns specific to the issues the Foundation championed. Working with a local advertising firm and media partners, the President of the Foundation and the Board of Directors of the Foundation created and implemented an awareness campaign.
