THE VISION FOR THE PARK IS TO ESTABLISH AN ENTREPRENEURIAL ATMOSPHERE IN A BUSINESS AND RESEARCH ENVIRONMENT WHICH FOSTERS CREATIVITY AND INNOVATION, AND EMBRACES COLLABORATION, PARTNERSHIPS, AND NETWORKING THAT LEADS TO ECONOMIC DIVERSIFICATION AND ENHANCED ECONOMIC VITALITY OF THE UNIVERSITY AND THE LOCAL COMMUNITY, STATE AND REGION. THE CITY OF AUBURN CONTRIBUTED \$5,000,000 IN-KIND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE UNIVERSITY AS IMPROVEMENTS TO THE LAND WHERE THE AUBURN RESEARCH PARK IS LOCATED.
