Lending by Bridgeway Capital benefited low-income people and assisted in the formation and growth of small businesses in low- to moderate-income communities across 15 counties in western Pennsylvania. More than 70 borrowers received loans totaling \$6,736,000, which leveraged over \$34 million in additional financing. Borrowers ranged from entrepreneurs starting their first business to daycares keeping their doors open through the state's budget crisis, charter and alternative schools, non-profits providing critical social services, and established businesses seeking to expand and develop their job base. The economic impact of this lending has helped preserve and create 642 jobs this year and more than 4,400 jobs over the last eight years.
