<p>What is the organization's primary exempt purpose?                      Book Wish Foundation's mission is to provide reading relief for people in crisis. In some of the world's most distressed places, we support reading to improve education, mental health, and occupational training. Books, reading glasses, library construction, solar lighting, and aid to schools are all part of our comprehensive, targeted approach to reading relief.</p> <p>Describe what was achieved in carrying out the organization's exempt purposes. In a clear and concise manner, describe the services provided, the number of persons benefited, or other relevant information for each program title.</p> <p><b>28</b> The program's objective is to provide comprehensive support for reading in the Bredjing, Treguine, and Gaga refugee camps in eastern Chad and in the nearby Chadian host villages of Abougkni, Barde, Bakhita, Bredjing, Faguire, Fodji, Hadjer Hadid, Kadjala, Kinouane, Kodolok Koundjan, Korkoguine, Koundoubla, Lira, Louma, Mobouguine, N'gourkoudji, Rataye, and Sira. The total population to be served is approximately 69,000 Darfuris in the refugee camps and approximately 19,000 Chadians in the villages. Program goals include supplying curriculum for the refugees' English classes, providing reading glasses, constructing libraries in each of the refugee camps, providing English/Arabic and French/Arabic dictionaries, providing school supplies, providing solar lighting suitable for group reading in schools and literacy classes, completing school construction in the villages, providing mini-libraries for the villages, and supplying curriculum for French and Arabic literacy classes in the villages (details at <a href="http://www.bookwish.org">http://www.bookwish.org</a>). Due to security concerns in the vicinity of the villages, it is expected that not all villages will receive all forms of support. All support is targeted as specifically as possible based on actual needs, as determined in partnership with CORD (<a href="http://www.cord.org.uk">http://www.cord.org.uk</a>), a UK-based charity managing education programs in these places as an implementing partner of UNHCR and UNICEF. During the fiscal year covered by this report: 1) The number of refugees learning English in the camps with textbooks supplied by this program increased to approximately 2,000, from about 1,180 at the end of the previous fiscal year. Before this program started, only 400 refugees were studying English, due to the lack of textbooks. Classes run six days a week, before and after regular school hours. 2) For the first time, a refugee English teacher's fluency in English has advanced to a level that the humanitarian aid worker who trains the teachers does not need to use an interpreter. 3) 1,750 pairs of reading glasses (with cases) were delivered to the refugee camps and surrounding villages, along with vision test charts and repair kits. This should enable refugees with vision problems (especially, age-related) to participate in literacy classes. Photographic documentation on <a href="http://www.bookwish.org">http://www.bookwish.org</a> shows many older refugees receiving reading glasses. The glasses were delivered despite an armed attack on the vehicle transporting them Abeche, Chad to Hadjer Hadid, Chad. 4) Eight different models of solar-rechargeable, portable lights were delivered to Chad for field testing as reading lights for groups meeting at night in the refugee camps and villages for literacy classes, teacher preparation, or teacher self-study. On the basis of field testing, extensive design work was performed with the manufacturer of one of the lights to make modifications to improve performance. The positive results of subsequent field testing occurred in the following fiscal year and will be reported in next year's report. 5) 78 English&lt;-&gt;Arabic and French&lt;-&gt;Arabic dictionaries were delivered to the refugee camps and surrounding villages. Note: After the fiscal year covered in this report, but before the filing of this report, substantial progress was made in funding a refugee camp library, the major goal of this program, which will be discussed in the subsequent fiscal year's report.
