Amendment #1: That Article II – Registered Office is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

ARTICLE II - REGISTERED OFFICE



The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Hinnesota Monprofit Corporation Act, Hinnesota Statutes, Chapter 317A, and all future lows amending and supplementing these statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

MITICE 1 - NAME

Bo part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, tay member, director, officer or other private person, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and expowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation consistent with Minnesota Statutes, Section 317A.701, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the lisbilities of the Corporation, dispose of all the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation or to an organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, in such manner as the Board of Directors shall determine.

In the event of dissolution, no assets shall be transferred to or in any respect inure to or for the benefit of any officer, member, employee or director of the Corporation.
