Franklins acute hospital admitted 2,145 patients and provided 6,899 days of care during the year. Hospital programs include provision of nursing care, extensive outpatient and inpatient surgical and endoscopic services, and diagnostic imaging services including CT, MRI, and mammography. Franklin provides a number of services targeting the specific health needs of its population, including diabetes management, home health, hospice, physical, speech, and occupational therapy programs, and cardiac and respiratory rehab. Franklin also provides an emergency department with 24-hour care, emergency transportation, and a chest pain and stroke program.
