

- A SUMMARY ON ONE PAGE: 1) Describe the chartered purpose of your organization in a paragraph of <u>50</u> words or fewer; and, 2) In <u>100 words or fewer</u>, describe why your organization is requesting this grant, the amount requested, how the grant will be used, and the outcome you hope to achieve.
- A STATEMENT from the head of the organization submitting the proposal indicating approval of the project. Any
 other required letters of support or approval for your project should be placed after this statement.
- A PROPOSAL not to exceed four pages in length that details the following:
 - 1. A statement of why the grant is needed in this region.
 - 2. A description of what the grant will be used to accomplish.
 - (3) A time-line outlining the beginning and completion of major project activities and descriptions of each.
 - 4. A list of the individuals who will implement and manage the grant along with a brief description of their qualifications relating to this project. (No resumes, please.)
 - 5. A description of how the grant relates to your organization's long-range planning and priorities.
 - 6. An explanation of how the effectiveness of the grant will be evaluated, and the name and address of the evaluator.

Place your materials in the order listed above. The application form <u>must</u> be the first document. Do not use a cover page, title pages, tabs, or any other excessive paper. Please <u>simply staple each copy (preferred)</u>, or use paper clips or binder clips. Proposals should be sent to the address above. The LPRVF Board of Directors' meetings are held quarterly.
