


STATEMENT 9

SEVENTH AMENDED AND RESTATED BYLAWS
OF
PLANNED PARENTHOOD ADVOCATES OF ARIZONA

ARTICLE I: PURPOSE

1. Purpose

Planned Parenthood Advocates of Arizona (PPAA) is organized to further the general welfare of the people of Arizona by working to promote public policies which encourage and protect informed individual choice regarding reproductive health care and guarantee each individual's right to full and nondiscriminatory access to reproductive health care. It is for the exclusive purpose of promoting social welfare within the meaning of section 501(c) (4) of the Internal Revenue Code. In connection with this purpose, PPAA shall:

- a. Encourage and protect informed individual choice regarding reproductive health care;
- b. Advocate public policies that guarantee the right to choice and non-discriminatory access to complete reproductive health care; and
- c. Foster and preserve a social and political climate favorable to the exercise of reproductive choice through candidate and voter education.

ARTICLE II: MEMBERS

1. Membership

PPAA Members shall be individuals who apply for membership, are found by the Board or such membership committee as it may establish to adhere to purposes of PPAA, as set out in these Bylaws, and pay whatever membership dues the Board may ordain. All Members shall have their membership formally acknowledged and shall be advised of their right to a copy of these Bylaws. PPAA through its Board, any membership committee established by the Board, and its membership shall expressly solicit new Members through whatever activities or channels the Board deems appropriate.

2. Limited Liability

No Member of PPAA shall be liable for the debts, obligations, or liabilities of PPAA by virtue of his/her membership.

ARTICLE III: DIRECTORS

1. Purpose

The management shall be consistent with PPAA purpose, subject to limitations in bylaws and to the limitation that prior to engaging in electoral activity involving direct candidate endorsement or expenditures to support or oppose a specific candidate, policies defining the scope and criteria for selection of such activities shall be adopted.

The Board shall exercise full power and authority to govern the affairs of the corporation, except as otherwise provided in these bylaws; shall approve a program for the ensuing year; shall ensure the financial viability of the corporation and safeguard its assets; may amend the bylaws; and shall conduct any special business of which due notice has been given by the Secretary in the notice of the meeting.

2. Number of Directors and Term of Office

The authorized number of Directors is no less than eight (8) and no more than twenty five (25). Directors will be appointed by the Planned Parenthood Arizona ("PPAZ") Board of Directors.

Directors shall begin serving a term of two (2) years upon the month following their election and until such time as new directors are duly elected. Directors may not be elected to more than three consecutive terms. No employee of PPAA may serve as a member of the Board of Directors.

3. Vacancies

A vacancy on the Board exists when: (a) a Director submits a written resignation; (b) the office is declared vacant by the Board pursuant to Section 4 of this Article; (c) the PPAZ Board of Directors fails to elect a sufficient number of Directors to fill all vacant positions; or (d) a Director takes a leave of absence. Vacancies shall be filled by the PPAZ Board of Directors. Each Director so elected shall hold office for the remainder of the term of the Director whose place such elected Director is taking.

4. Removal

A Director may be removed from the Board with or without cause by a vote of a majority of the PPAZ Board of Directors.

5. Board Meetings

The Board shall meet regularly at least four (4) times during each fiscal year.

Special meetings of the Board of Directors for any purpose may be called at any time by the Chair or by two of the Directors currently in office.

Notice of both regular and special meetings shall be given at least two (2) days in advance and shall specify the place, day, and hour of such meetings. Notice may be mailed, electronically transferred by modem or facsimile, hand delivered, or delivered via telephone. If delivered in such a manner, such notice shall be deemed to be given when sent by the sender.

The Board of Directors may permit any or all Directors to participate in a regular or special meeting by, or conduct the meeting through, the use of any means of communication by which all Directors participating may simultaneously hear each other during the meeting. A Director participating in a meeting by this means is deemed to be present in person at the meeting.

6. Quorum

One-third (1/3) of the duly qualified Directors shall constitute a quorum. Every act or decision done or made by a majority of the Directors present at a meeting duly held at which a quorum is present shall be regarded as the act of the Board of Directors.

All actions require only simple majority of the Directors present, except that the following matters shall require a 2/3 majority of the quorum: amendments to these Bylaws and the Articles of Incorporation, and action to dissolve PPAA.

7. Board Actions Outside of Meetings

The Board may take action without a meeting if the Chair or any two Directors currently in office contact all members of the Board in a single electronic mail transmission soliciting Board action, and a majority of all Directors expressly approve of the solicited action by responsive electronic transmission to the Chair or relevant two Directors within seventy-two (72) hours of the original transmission.

8. Conflict of Interest

When a situation exists whereby a member of the Board of Directors may benefit or suffer from doing business with PPAA, the Board member has the responsibility to make all circumstances known to the Board of Directors at a regularly scheduled meeting. Under such circumstances, the Board member will be excused from the meeting until the matter has been resolved by the other Board members present at the meeting.

ARTICLE IV: OFFICERS

1. Election of Officers

The Board of Directors shall elect the officers of the corporation. The officers to be elected shall serve a term of two years, and shall include a Chair, a Vice-Chair, a Secretary and a Treasurer. The offices of Secretary and Treasurer may be held by the same person or by two separate individuals. The Board of Directors may, at its sole discretion, hire a President/Chief Executive Officer. The new officers shall take office on the day of their election unless some other date is designated by the Board.

The Board of Directors may elect additional officers from time to time as deemed necessary or desirable for the operation of PPAA. In the event of a vacancy in any office, the Board of Directors shall elect a Director to fill the vacancy as soon as practicable.

2. Titles and Duties of Officers

The power and duties of the officers shall be as follows:

A. Chair

The Chair shall be the presiding officer of the Board of Directors, and shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors. The Chair may call both regular and special meetings of the Board, and shall exercise and perform such other powers and duties as may be assigned to that office from time to time by the Board of Directors or prescribed by these Bylaws.

The Chair (and President/Chief Executive Officer if the Board elects to have such a position) shall be the only individual(s) authorized to approve contracts on behalf of PPAA. Expenditure of any corporate funds deposited in a segregated fund, which is registered as a political committee under Arizona law, must also be approved by the officer designated as the Treasurer of that Fund, or by the Chair of the Fund if permitted by law.

B. Vice-Chair

In the absence or disability of the Chair, the Vice-Chair shall perform all the duties of the Chair and when so acting shall have all the powers of, and be subject to all restrictions upon, the Chair. The Vice-Chair shall have such other powers and perform such other duties as from time to time may be prescribed by the Board of Directors or these Bylaws.

C. Secretary

The Secretary shall: (a) see that the minutes of all meetings of the Board of Directors and of any committees are kept; (b) give or cause to be given required notices of all meetings of the Board of Directors; and (c) discharge such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the Board of Directors or the President/Chief Executive Officer, if such an officer is hired.

D. Treasurer

The Treasurer shall: (a) have or provide for the custody of the funds or other property of PPAA and keep a separate book account of the same; (b) collect, receive and deposit or provide for the collection, receipts and deposit of monies earned by or in any manner due to or received by PPAA; (c) whenever so required by the Board of Directors, render, or cause to be rendered, an accounting showing his or her transactions as Treasurer and the financial condition of PPAA; and (d) discharge such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the Board of Directors or the Board Chair.

E. President/Chief Executive Officer

The Board of Directors may employ a President/Chief Executive Officer who shall manage the operations of the corporation and execute policy set by the Board. The President/Chief Executive Officer, if that office is filled, shall implement and maintain a record of the policies of the Board of Directors, including the maintenance of a docket of any termination or review dates of such policies. The President/Chief Executive Officer shall not be a member of the Board.

ARTICLE V: PERSONAL LIABILITY

The personal liability of any Director or volunteer officer of PPAA to PPAA for money damages for breach of fiduciary duty or any action taken or any failure to take any action as a Director or officer is hereby eliminated to the fullest extent allowed by the Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of Arizona, as it may be amended from time to time.

ARTICLE VI: INDEMNIFICATION

PPAA shall indemnify, and advance expenses to, to the fullest extent allowed by the Arizona Revised Statutes, any person who incurs liability or expense by reason of such person acting as a Director or officer of PPAA. This indemnification with respect to Directors and officers shall be mandatory, subject to the requirements of the Arizona Revised Statutes, in all circumstances in which indemnification is permitted by the Arizona Revised Statutes. In addition, PPAA may, in its sole discretion, indemnify, and advance expenses to any person who incurs liability or expense, by reason of such person acting as an employee or agent of PPAA, to the fullest extent allowed by the Arizona Revised Statutes.

ARTICLE VII: AMENDMENTS

These Bylaws may be changed or amended at a regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors provided that all Directors are given at least ten (10) days written notice that such a change or amendment will be voted upon. A vote of two thirds (2/3) of the number of all Directors present at a regular or special meeting of the Board is required to amend these Bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII: DISSOLUTION

PPAA shall dissolve upon the written notice of the PPAA Board of Directors. Upon dissolution of PPAA, the assets remaining after payment of all debts and obligations shall be distributed to PPAZ.
