CITC employs third-party compensation consultants to provide substantiated comparability data. The compensation committee approves, on an annual basis, the salary and incentive pay for the President and CEO. Both the deliberation and documentation of this decision are documented in the minutes of the Finance Committee. CITC's Compensation Committee also reviews market data (again provided by an independent entity) that serves as the basis for the salary ranges for CITC's Executive Team. An independent compensation consultant provides CITC with market data from organizations that are similar in scope and size to CITC. From the data, the Compensation Committee approves salary ranges that set the minimum and maximum salary amounts for a given level of responsibility. The deliberation process is documented in both documents submitted to the Committee for their review and also in the Committee meeting minutes that are taken at each meeting.
