Standardize farm seeds with use of grades, inspection services, brands, trade-marks and reduce wastes in production and handling.

Statement of Program Service Accomplishments

Promoted the production of seeds. Analyzed costs and charges for production. Assembled and disseminated data on farm seeds and other agricultural products. The Oregon Seed Growers League meets annually in December to discuss matters of technical importance to the industry. The two-day event is normally attended by 350-400 growers and industry representatives. In addition, a trade show runs concurrently with the education program. Thirty-five to 40 exhibitors are expected each year.
