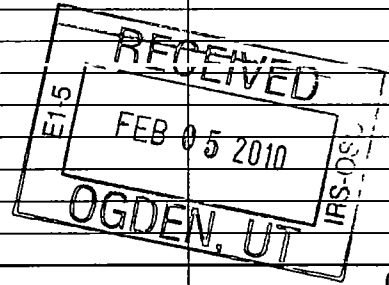

Line 2d. – Grants are limited to qualified organizations for specific projects in broad areas of interest as follows:

- Hunger and poverty in the United States
- Mental health in the United States
- Support of Education
- Development and support of programs directed to the enhancement of human rights throughout the world.

The Lucy Pang Yoa Chang Foundation does not directly administer programs it supports. Recipients are asked, however, to submit periodic progress reports and an evaluation of whether the objectives of the grant were achieved.

In general, the foundation makes grants only for specific projects and does not provide funds for endowment or building programs, for grants to individuals, or for annual fund raising campaigns. Unfortunately, many worthy requests must be turned down each year, either because needs far exceed the foundation’s limited resources or because a given project does not fall within the current program guidelines.
