Several years in the past, the Grand Lodge Trustees saw a need to provide for the endowment of the Grand Lodge as an ongoing institution. This was done by several means which included soliciting contributions from Masons in Texas and the distribution of promotional labels and pins with a solicitation for contributions. These solicitations were accompanied with the stipulation that the monies were to be deposited in an endowment fund from which only the investment earnings would be withdrawn for the future benefit of the Grand Lodge. The trustees also elected to retain only \$1,000,000 of accumulated net operating revenues as unrestricted fund balance and to transfer any excess to the permanently restricted Funded Endowment Fund. The result of these efforts is that the Funded Endowment Fund has been created with a permanently restricted balance of \$1,590,101 and a board designated balance of unrestricted net assets in the amount of \$5,295,038 as of October 31, 2008, from which only future investment earnings will be withdrawn.
